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Answer **three** questions.

- 1** Jenny recently bought an expensive refrigerator from ABC Kitchens. It has now broken down.

Explain the most relevant methods of alternative dispute resolution (ADR) available to Jenny. Discuss the advantages and disadvantages of each method. [25]

- 2** Both the way in which lay magistrates are selected and the training they receive are inadequate.

Describe both the selection and training of lay magistrates. Assess whether the statement above is justified. [25]

- 3** Explain how the system of precedent operates. Assess the extent to which there are adequate ways for a judge to avoid precedent. [25]

- 4** Describe **three** types of delegated legislation. Assess whether the advantages of delegated legislation outweigh the disadvantages. [25]

- 5** Marie has been arrested for theft of a car and taken to Barchester Police Station for questioning.

Explain Marie's rights once she arrives at the police station. Assess the extent to which these rights make the job of the police investigating crime difficult. [25]

- 6** Explain the recruitment and selection process for the judiciary. Assess how far it is true to say that the right people are chosen for the job. [25]

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
