

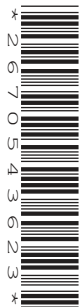

Section C: Religion**EITHER**

- 5** 'The role of religion is to prevent conflict in society.' Evaluate this view. [35]

- 6** 'All societies are experiencing a decline in religiosity.' Evaluate this view. [35]

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
