- 3 *Amazon* is a multinational business that trades online. Customers order goods from it, which are then delivered to them.

Amazon sells a wide range of goods including electronic equipment, toys, home furnishings, sporting goods, fashion clothing and footwear.

It has many large distribution warehouses that make deliveries to its customers.

Amazon has a membership scheme called Amazon Prime. Customers pay a monthly subscription to have their goods delivered without a charge being made. Customers who do not pay for Amazon Prime are charged a delivery fee for each item delivered.
