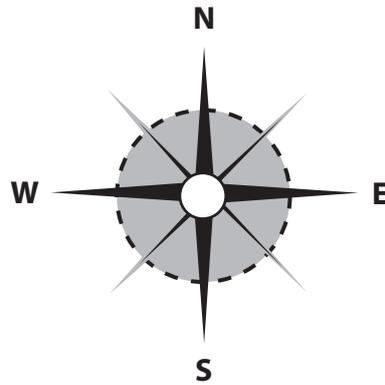

The structure of the **CRUISE** table is:

Field name	Data type	Description/Example
CRUISE ID	Text	Code to identify the cruise – primary key
CRUISE TYPE	Text	Cruise only or include a stay on land
DESTINATION	Text	Where the cruise will go
CRUISE NAME	Text	

The **GUEST** table includes information about the guests who have booked the cruises.

The structure of the **GUEST** table is:

Field name	Data type	Description/Example
GUEST ID	Text	Code to identify the guest – primary key
LAST NAME	Text	
EMAIL	Text	
CABIN CHOICE	Text	Balcony, Inside, Ocean View, Suite
NUMBER OF GUESTS	Number	

The **BOOKING** table includes information about the cruises and the guests who have booked the cruises.

The structure of the **BOOKING** table is:

Field name	Data type	Description/Example
BOOKING ID	AutoNumber	Code to identify the booking – primary key
CRUISE ID	Text	Code to identify the cruise
GUEST ID	Text	Code to identify the guest
HOLIDAY DATE	Date/time	Date of departure
HOLIDAY LENGTH (NIGHTS)	Number	Number of nights the guest is on the ship

- include the heading 'Guests for 2026 cruises'
- display the heading with:
 - width set to 7 cm and height set to 1 cm

 - white text
 - a red border set to 2 pt
- include an automated date in the form header formatted to display as DD/MM/YYYY

Task A2d

Kimora wants some information on cruises.

The list must:

- include the guests who have booked CRUISE ONLY with a BALCONY
- show only these fields in this order **LAST NAME, NUMBER OF GUESTS, DESTINATION, CRUISE NAME** and **HOLIDAY DATE**

Create a query on the three tables to find the information.

SAVE the query as **CRUISE QUERY**

Kimora wants a database report based on the results from the **CRUISE QUERY**

Create a database report to display the results.

The database report must:

- be set to landscape
- have a suitable title with a dark background and white bold text
- show only the required fields
- group on **NUMBER OF GUESTS**
- include the date in the report header
- ensure no page numbers are displaying on the report
- set the field names to display with a shadowed effect
- ensure all data is visible.

Kimora wants you to create two web pages for *Cruises'* new website. Content for the **HOME** page is stored in the file **WEB PAGE**

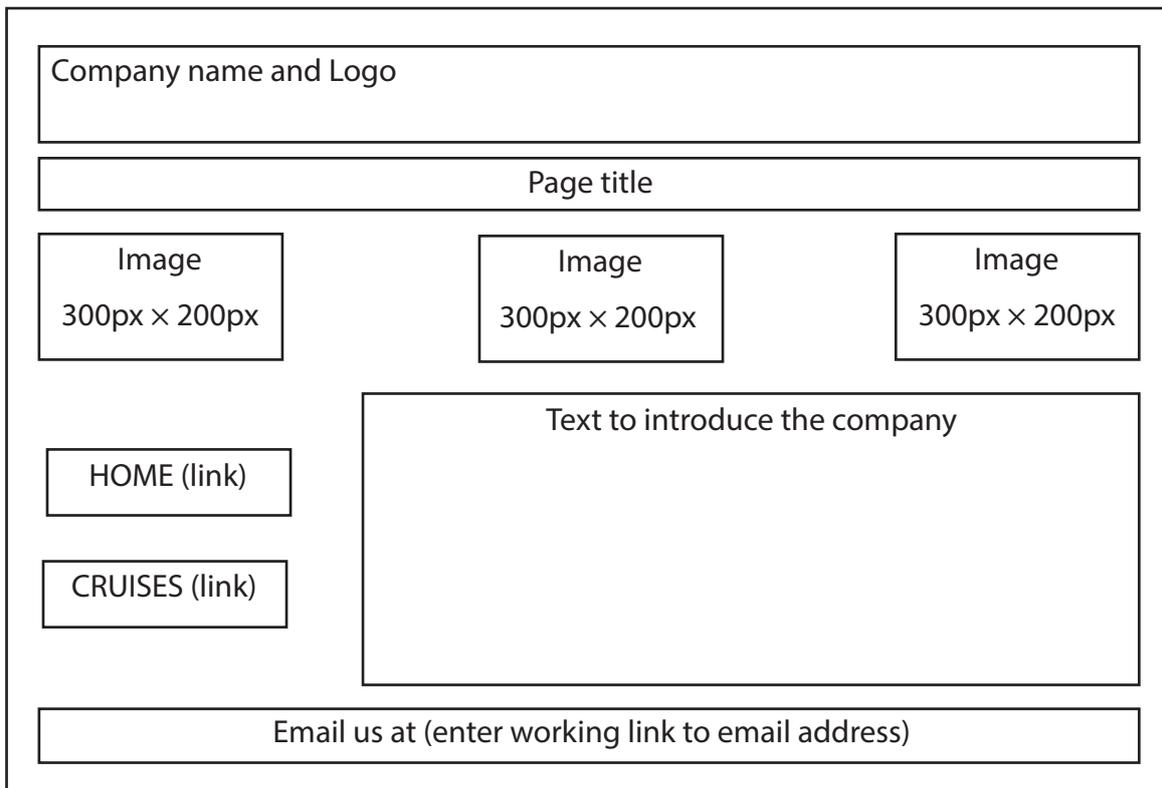
Create a folder to save your web pages and the assets you have used.

Company name <h1> and italics <i>

Page title <h2> and underline <u>

Introduction text <p>

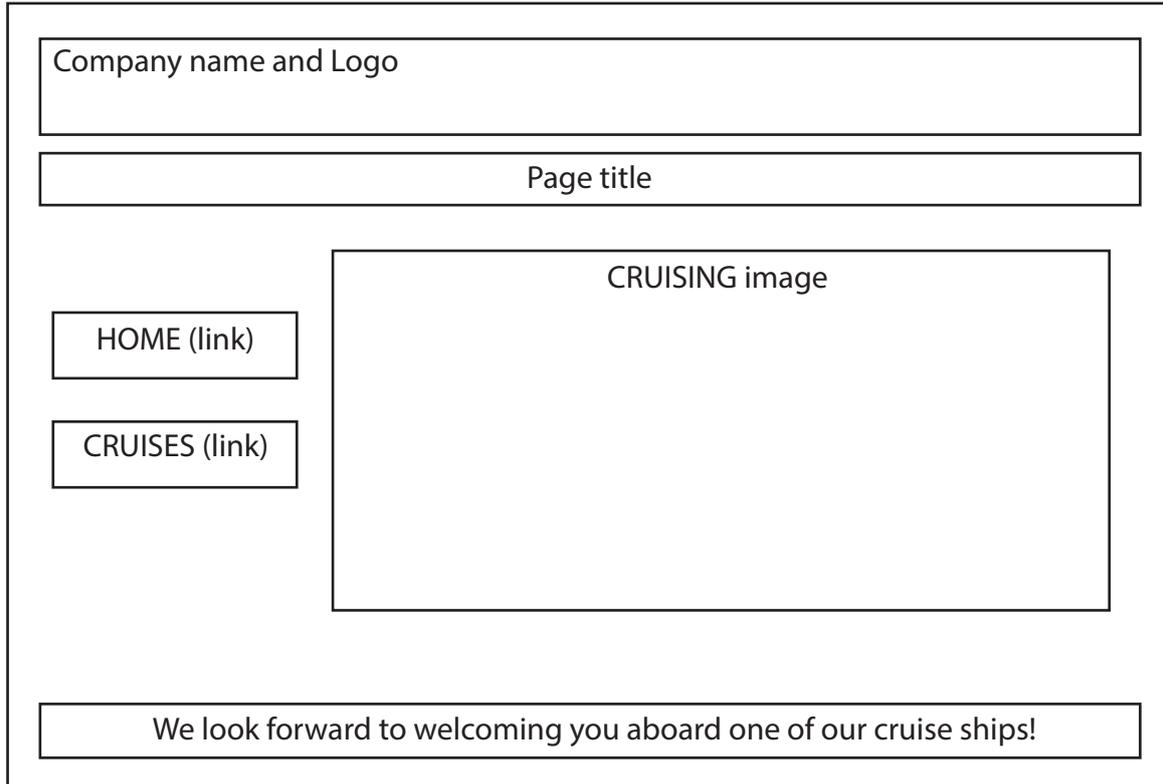
Include three appropriate images from the **IMAGES** folder and position them as shown in the design.

SECTION B

Task B1

Cruises offers cruises around the world.

The spreadsheet **CRUISE PAYMENTS** contains information on payments made for a cruise for one of the guests.

It has three worksheets called **COSTS**, **INFORMATION** and **CHART**

Some functions require you to use different worksheets.

OPEN the spreadsheet **CRUISE PAYMENTS**

Task B1a

- (i) Insert a new row at the top of the **COSTS** worksheet and enter the heading CRUISE COSTS (1)
- (ii) Merge and centre cells A1 to C1 (1)
- (iii) Unmerge row 3 (1)
- (iv) Format the **COSTS** worksheet to:
- use dark shading and white text for the heading
 - set the heading to font size 24
 - change the CRUISE DATE format to display as 27/08/2026 (3)

Task B1b

Kimora wants you to use spreadsheet tools to analyse the data in the spreadsheet.

- (i) Use one spreadsheet function to display the cost in 2026 of the *CABIN UPGRADE* (4)
- (ii) Use a function to calculate the *TOTAL COST* (1)
- (iii) Use a formula to calculate the *COST WITH DEDUCTIONS* (2)
- (iv) If the date of the cruise is after July 2026 an additional 10% discount is given. If a discount is not given, the cell must be left blank. Use a function to display the value of discount that may be given. (4)
- (v) Enter a formula to calculate *FINAL AMOUNT TO PAY* (1)

Task B1c

Format the **COSTS** worksheet so that:

- currency values show the currency symbol (£) with two decimal places (1)
- cell A10 uses text wrap and the cell contents are fully displayed (1)
- only the cells that include data must have a border (1)
- row and column headings are displayed when the spreadsheet is printed. (1)

Task B2

The chart on the **CHART** worksheet shows the upgrade costs. Format the chart to:

- include suitable axis titles
- edit the series labels with suitable names
- change the colours of the bars to two different shades of green. (3)

Task B3**SAVE** the spreadsheet as **FILTER**

Kimora wants to see some information.

- (iii) Filter the **INFORMATION** worksheet to show the UPGRADE COST for SUITE in 2025 and 2026. Make sure that *AVERAGE UPGRADE COST* is still visible. (2)
